This event which allows the community to rally around an endearing love for animals, enthusiastically welcomes people of any ability, language, age, orientation, documentation status, race or economic class to participate in a safe, free, community-building event where they are valued and encouraged to have fun. Extra focus through funding, translation and networking will be directed to intentionally invite marginalized youth and families, specifically those affected by financial hardship, foster-care and discrimination. Confirmed Activities: Belmont Goats as Grand Marshalls, Fire Dept providing on-site engine tours, "Ask a Vet" table by a local veterinarian, Humane Society sharing about their foster program, animal-assisted therapy training and low cost spay/neuter financial support. We also plan to have benevolent professionals providing animal balloons, face-painting, prizes and pet photography. The Boys & Girls Club have offered their location and will be an additional partner.
