- **Item 1 – Parkrose-Argay Development Study (Barry Manning)**
Barry explained the purpose of the study is to determine what type of development the neighborhood would like to see in the Rossi Farms area should future development occur.

Suzanne discussed the importance of protecting our groundwater due to the aquifer that runs underneath our area. This aquifer is used as a secondary water source by the City of Portland. They have several events throughout the year. There is a workshop called Groundwater 101 which will be held next on Saturday, January 26, 2019 at 9:00am.
