YES, WE CAN TAKE: (restrictions over)

BULKY WASTE:

- Furniture, Mattresses
- Scrap lumber
- Stumps less than 18" in diameter
- Plumbing fixtures (toilets, sinks, tubs)

METAL:

- Appliances WITHOUT Freon
- Dishwashers and trash compactors
- Water heaters
- Washers and Dryers
- Stoves, BBQ grills
- Drained lawn mowers (no oil/gas)

Please prepare your loads IN ADVANCE to expedite wait times. Volunteers are limited so please know you must be able to handle the disposal drop if needed. Thank you for your understanding.
