March 25th, 2019

Members from Transitions Projects and the Wy'East Shelter came to provide an update. Everything has been going well recently with no incidents. They are in need of men's pants, socks and underwear donations.

Members of DePaul Treatment Center came to discuss the plans for a residential and in-patient treatment center to be built in 2020 on the corner of 102 and Cherry Blossom. Plans include spaces for 46 men's beds and 24 women's beds as well as an out patient program with a focus on family services. DePaul is working with PBOT to discuss solutions for improving 102nd Ave.

A representative from BottleDrop to talk their blue bag program that can be used for fundraising.

A representative from the Mercy Corp came to talk about the Community Investment Trust program. New financial classes are happening on April 13th and April 20th. You must take the classes in order to sign up. Members can choose to invest \$10 or up to \$100 a month.
